

Calgary Girls' School

Legacy Fund Scholarship Application Undergraduate Programs

PURPOSE

The purpose of this scholarship is to support Calgary Girls' School graduates in enrolling in post-secondary education at a recognized educational or training institution. There will be one scholarship awarded at a value of \$4,000. Alumni may apply only once for this award.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify, applicants must be Calgary Girls' School graduates. In the instance where an award is made, the recipient must provide the Calgary Girls' School with evidence of enrolment in an accredited program by June 1 of the year that the award is offered. Upon receipt of this evidence, a cheque in the amount of \$4,000 will be released to the recipient. In the instance where no evidence is provided, the award will be forfeit. The school reserves the right to award only if applications are considered worthy and appropriate by the Selection Committee. In a year, where no awards are made, these funds will return to the Legacy Fund.

SELECTION

Applications will be reviewed by a committee, which is chaired by the principal and includes one teacher and one "friend of the school".

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are required to submit the following in one complete package to the attention of the Principal, Calgary Girls' School no later than due date posted on the website.

1. A cover page, which states your current address, phone number(s) and e-mail address.
2. Three letters of reference. These letters will be focused as follows
 - A letter which speaks to the applicant's capacity as a scholar
 - A letter which addresses the applicant's demonstrated leadership ability
 - A letter which describes the applicant's experience in offering service.
3. A current/most recent high school transcript.
4. A 500 word (minimum) essay, which addresses the following:
 - In consideration of your future plans: what do you believe has been the Impact of CGS on your development as a young woman, the choices you have made in relation to your future plans, and the manner in which you will conduct

yourself in your chosen career?

- Please include specific examples and stories, including those related to the Go Grrrls curriculum.
- As an “old girl”, how do you see yourself “giving back” to the CGS community?

Faxed applications or e-mailed applications will not be considered.
