CGCS Parent/School Council is not a fundraising body. The CGCS Society holds a license for a casino, and our Direct donation campaign, thus all the funds raised by those 2 events are held and administered by the CGCS Society/Board. (they can issue tax receipts) CGCS parents fulfill the volunteer roles and requirements to work the casino and promote the Direct Donation Campaign. A plan on how to spend the funds was created collaboratively by council, parents, administration and the society. For Casino, a budget, or "Buckets" were created based on percentages of the total casino funds. 25% Healthy Living, 25% Fine Arts, 15% Maintenance, 25% Innovation and 10% Miscellaneous for Option Courses. For Direction Donation Campaign, the past few years we have supported grade team "Innovation Projects". Our last casino was Feb 2019 and Direct Donation Campaign is in the fall.

Please find the details of the last June Treasurer's report in the handout. It goes over in detail how we had a fantastic year of uniform sales and we went under budget on most items, so we had an overage of funds to spend on a wish list. The wish list is still being filled to do the change in admin, but I can report we have our new couches, table and chairs in the LC, dishwashers, art supplies for BA, we are waiting for science microscopes and LV art equipment as well as other items from the list.

I'd like to go over our budget that set and voted on in June. Each line item has a budget, for example if you are organizing the October International Day of the teacher you would see your budget is \$200 for teacher treats.

Currently, we have a deposit of \$1024.23 from last spring's healthy hunger lunches. And expenses of \$59 for hungry girl lunch supplies and \$95 for new parent meeting supplies.

<u>Highlights include</u>:

Fundraising - The Apple fundraiser netted \$1743.12 to help support our Fruit program, which was \$2354 at the end of May. Healthy Hunger was poplar and generated \$11,396.56, including approx. \$2000 from last year. The used Uniform sales were huge successes generating a revenue of \$12,525.15. Expenses – Parent speaker series was increased to \$1500 for Allan Donsky. All other line items were completely spent or came in a bit under budget.
