<p><b>Instructional Resources</b> Includes materials and supplies for student use and off campus PE activities. <p><b>Transportation Fee</b> We provide bussing from all four quadrants of the city. Bussing routes are created based on enrollment of students and can change yearly. Fees are based on the difference between funding and costs. Only 30% of transportation costs are funded by Alberta Education. <p><b>Enrichment Fee</b> One-time school fee is used for the enrichment of student programming throughout the year, such as field trips, special events, guest speakers, and specialized equipment. <i>*Does not include overnight camps or outdoor education experiences</i></p>	<p>\$75 (grades 4-9)</p>	<p>Due October 1st</p>
<p><b>Lunchroom Supervision Fees</b> We are a closed-campus school. All students remain on campus during the lunch hour. This cost covers supervision for the entire year offered by an external company.</p>	<p>Approximately \$175</p>	<p>Due October 1st</p>
<p><b>Grade 9 Graduation</b> Fee to support the associated costs to celebrate the graduation of grade 9 students from their programming at CGCS</p>	<p>\$50</p>	<p>Due February 1st</p>

<p><b>Technology</b> CGCS is a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) school. Students are required to bring a tablet or laptop to school daily. In our classrooms we use the technology to access learning tools that are web based (Google Classroom). <p><b>Athletics/Robotics (extracurricular)</b> Students wishing to participate in our athletics and/or robotics program will be assigned fees. Fees associated with athletics and robotics are cost-recovery and vary, depending on sport/activity.</p>	<p>Range from \$15 (cross country) - \$90 (basketball)</p>	<p>Due at the beginning of season</p>
<p><b>Yearbook Fee (Optional)</b></p>	<p>\$35</p>	<p>Due June 1st</p>
<p><b>Before and After School Care (Optional)</b> Kinderstudios is a licensed before and aftercare program. Their program runs Monday through Friday 7:00 AM to 6:00 pm out of the North Glenmore Park Community Association building, located adjacent to the Lakeview campus. Transportation to and from the Bel Aire campus is available at an additional cost of \$180/year.
